Promotional Cards



- Distributed to all students with library card attached
- Highlight most valuable resources for educators and parents
- Easy to change the color from year to year
- Parental information letters

Logistics for Distribution & Use

- Each classroom receives:
 - Large promotional cards – students take these home for parental review
 - Classroom set of Tech Cards (on a ring) – for classroom use
- How to *distribute* Tech Cards:
 - Teachers distribute cards at beginning of lesson
 - Gather cards at end of lesson and keep on rings for next use
 - Can distribute cards to students at end of school year for summer use (cards expire Aug 1st each year)
- How to *use* Tech Cards:
 - Find resource to use in Student Portal under “Grades K-4”
 - Type in Tech Card number (back of card)
 - Type in Pin # - 1234

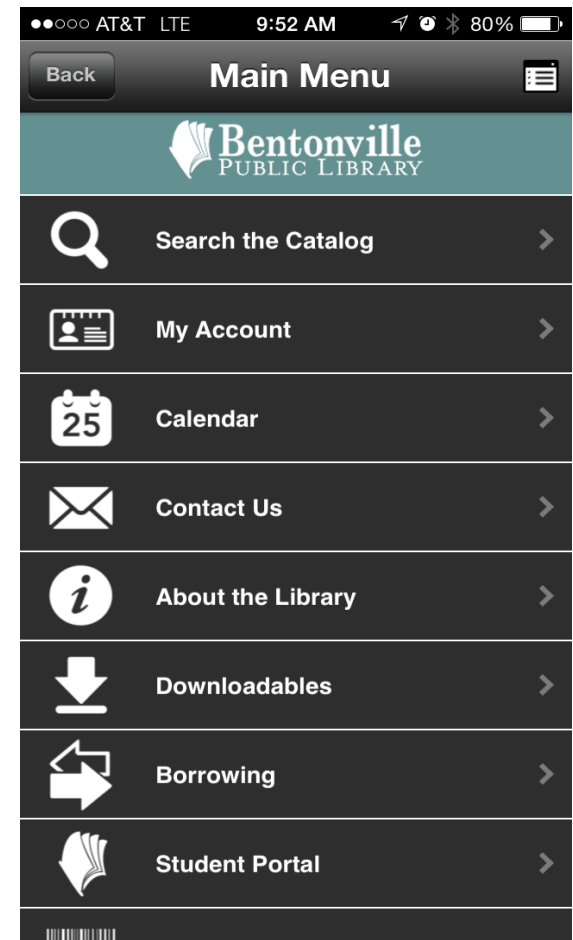

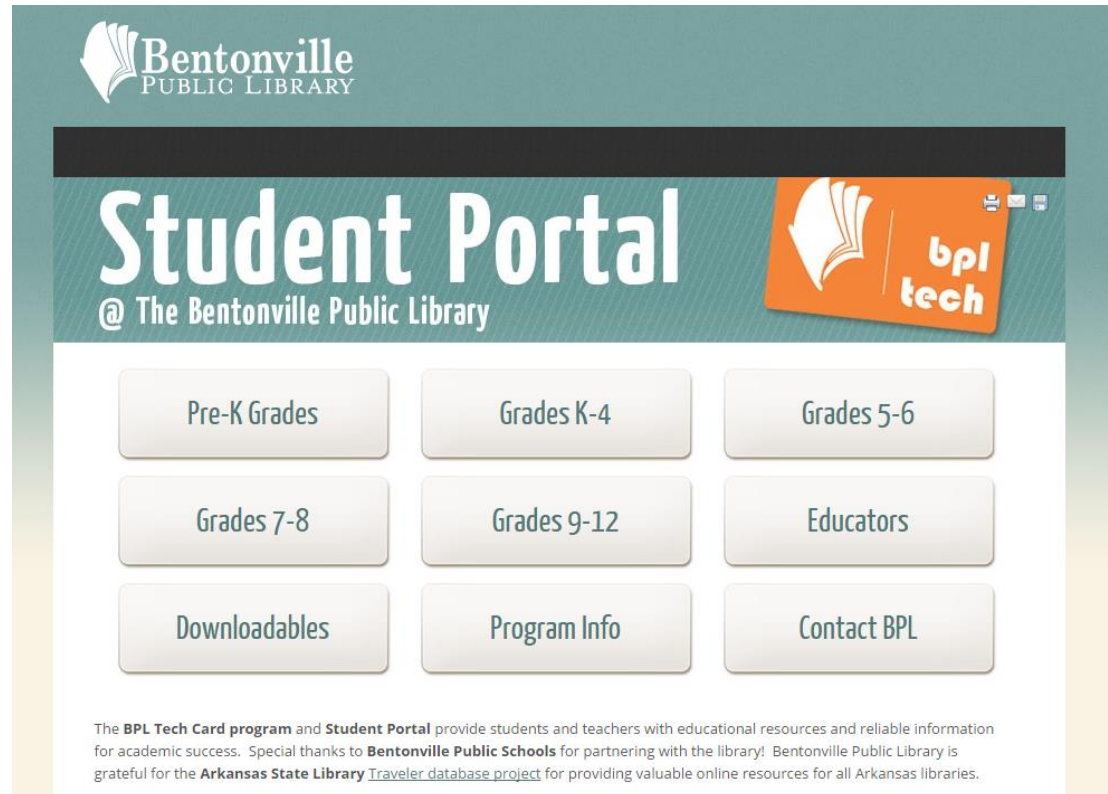
